ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE NEW JERSEY BISHOPS

Reinstating the General Obligation to Attend Mass

At this time, due to the observance of public safety protocols and the increase in the availability of vaccines, we have begun a return to some sense of normalcy in various sectors of our society.

Therefore, we the Catholic Bishops of New Jersey, are lifting the dispensation of the Sunday and Holy Days Mass obligation beginning on Saturday, June 5, 2021, and Sunday, June 6, 2021, Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. We welcome the Christian faithful to return to the regular participation in the Sunday Eucharist, the source and summit of our Catholic faith (cf. Code of Canon Law canon 1247 and Catechism of the Catholic Church, n. 2180).

This obligation does not apply to those who are ill; those who have reason to believe that they were recently exposed to the coronavirus or another serious or contagious illness; those who are confined to their home, a hospital, or nursing facility; or those with serious underlying health conditions. One should consult the local pastor if questions arise about the obligation to attend Mass (canon 87).

Finally, safety protocols (such as wearing masks, social distancing, etc.) and liturgical directives in each New Jersey Diocese remains in place until modified or revoked by the respective Diocesan Bishop.



Memorial of "Mary, Mother of the Church" to be Celebrated on Monday, May 24

Pope Francis three years ago established a new feast day honoring Mary. On Monday, May 24, 2021, Latin-rite Catholics around the world will mark the feast of "**The Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church**" on the Monday immediately after Pentecost Sunday.

The Gospel reading for the feast, which technically is called a "memorial," is John 19:25-34, which recounts how from the Cross Jesus entrusted Mary to His disciples as their mother and entrusted His disciples to Mary as her children.

When Pope Francis issued the decree (March 3, 2018) announcing the addition of this memorial to the Church calendar, he noted that he had "attentively considered how greatly the promotion of this devotion might encourage the growth of the maternal sense of the church in the pastors, religious and faithful, as well as a growth of genuine Marian piety."

Honoring Mary as **Mother of the Church** on the day after Pentecost highlights for Catholics that Mary was present with the disciples on Pentecost, praying with them as the Holy Spirit descended. It has been said that Mary "from the awaiting of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, has never ceased to take motherly care of the pilgrim church on earth."

Here at St. Michael's and within the Diocese of Trenton our recognition of, and devotion to, Mary as **our spiritual mother** and as **Mother of the Church** is long-standing, vibrant, and strong:

- The patron saint of our Diocese (since its founding in 1881) is the Blessed Mother.
- Our Cathedral in downtown Trenton-the Cathedral of Saint Mary of the Assumption-is dedicated to the Blessed Mother. The Cathedral is the **Mother Church** of our diocese.
- Our "Jesus windows" - - the series of eight stained glass windows that adorn the south side of our church - - include images of Mary in her maternal role as Mother of Jesus and Mother of God (the Annunciation, Incarnation, Epiphany, Presentation, and Crucifixion). In the beautiful grotto at the rear of our church, St. Bernadette Soubirous kneels in prayer as she gazes upward at Mary, Our Lady of Lourdes (Notre Dame de Lourdes). Please take a moment during these final days of the Easter Season to reflect on the images of Mary in the windows and to say a quiet prayer to the **Mother of the Church** and to **YOUR spiritual mother**. Incidentally, the Jesus windows mentioned above are opposite the series of nine Old Testament windows (Melchidezek, Abraham, Pharaoh's daughter, Queen Esther (type of the Blessed Mother), etc.) along the north side of the church.
