



Justice is the moral virtue of giving proper respect and due. It shows that we have a correct understanding and appreciation for something. In St. John Paul II's words, ...man has specific responsibility towards the environment in which he lives, towards the creation which God has put at the service of his personal dignity, of his life, not only for the present but also for future generations.



We have fallen a concerning distance behind the pace of recent years in the Diocesan Annual Appeal as noted in last week's bulletin (10.7% behind 2022 as of our most recent tallies). The three "thermometers" above compare our parish's 2021 vs. 2022 vs. 2023 results-to-date in the Annual Catholic Appeal. The thermometers indicate good news. This year's total after fourteen weekends is strong, although it is behind the pace after the same first fourteen weekends of last year and the year before that. Thank you for your support of the Annual Catholic Appeal. *Together we can do great things!*

*This \$78,134 figure is approximately 71.6% of our parish goal. It was received through and including the fourteenth weekend of the campaign (tallied as of May 30) from 240 pledgers or check-writing contributors (and many unidentified, unquantified cash contributors) all of whom comprise approximately 11.2% of the 2,127 registered households of the parish. Thank you! The Diocese sent a Diocesanwide mailing during the week of February 10 to all of our registered parishioners and past ACA contributors asking for prayerful consideration of a pledge/contribution to the Appeal. Please help to the extent that you can.
