


October: Month of the Holy Rosary

The month of October each year is dedicated to the Most Holy Rosary. This is primarily due to the fact that the liturgical memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated annually on October 7. This memorial was instituted to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary in gratitude for the protection that she gives the Church and her spiritual children in answer to the praying of the Rosary by the faithful.




The memorial was introduced by Pope St. Pius V in the year 1571 to commemorate the miraculous victory of the Christian forces in the Battle of Lepanto on October 7, 1571. The Pope attributed more to the "arms" of the Rosary than to the power of cannons and the valor of the soldiers who fought there.

In this month of October, let us consider this beautiful prayer of the Rosary as a means that we, too, can use in order to draw closer to Jesus and Mary by meditating on the great mysteries of our salvation.



National Eucharistic Revival

MY FLESH FOR THE LIFE OF THE WORLD

WHAT IS IT ?

WHAT IS THE NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL?

The National Eucharistic Revival is a three-year initiative sponsored by the Bishops of the United States to inspire and prepare the People of God to be formed, healed, concerted, united, and sent out to a hurting and hungry world through a renewed encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist – the source and summit of our Catholic faith. The revival has officially begun in June 2022, and its milestone event will be a National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis, Indiana, from July 17-21, 2024. The National Eucharistic Revival and National Eucharistic Congress are a direct response to the Holy Father's call for a "pastoral and missionary conversion which cannot leave things as they presently are" so that the Church in the United States might be "permanently in a state of mission." (*Evangelii Gaudium*, n. 25)

This Eucharistic movement seeks to bring together clergy, religious, laity, apostolates, movements, and parish and diocesan leaders to spur momentum, collaboration, and lasting impact for the renewal of the Catholic Church in the U.S. over the next three years. Each year will have a strategic focus for formation and missionary discipleship.

June 19, 2022

We launch our national response to the Lord's call with widespread eucharistic processions and adoration on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

WHAT'S NEXT ?

YEAR OF DIOCESAN REVIVAL

2022 – 2023

This first year of the Revival invites diocesan staff, bishops, and priests to respond to the Lord's personal invitation and equips them to share this love with the faithful through Eucharistic congresses and events.

YEAR OF PARISH REVIVAL

2023 – 2024

The second phase will foster Eucharistic devotion at the parish level, strengthening our liturgical life through faithful celebration of the Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, missions, resources, preaching, and organic movements of the Holy Spirit.

NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS

July 2024

At this historic event, more than 80,000 Catholics of all ages will gather in Indianapolis to reconsecrate their hearts to the source and summit of our faith.

YEAR OF GOING OUT ON MISSION

2024 – 2025

Having enkindled a missionary fire in the hearts of the American faithful, the Holy Spirit will send us out on mission to share the gift of our Eucharistic Lord.





Update re the Annual Catholic Appeal 2022: Congratulations! And Thank You!

Our Gospel reading last Sunday (Jesus' healing of the ten lepers – Luke 17:11-19) presented us with a vivid moment in which gratitude is expressed and an equally vivid moment in which gratitude fails to be expressed. And so without missing out on the opportunity, please allow me to say "THANK YOU!" and also "CONGRATULATIONS!" to all those who have contributed to this year's Diocese of Trenton Annual Catholic Appeal ("ACA").

Our parish has again reached (and surpassed) its goal for the ACA. As reported in the bulletin a few weeks ago, we reached our very large goal of \$109,000. This was a combination of fundraising and development funds and pledged-but-not-yet-collected amounts. We had committed to go beyond the "raised funds" "hedge" against the potential for a few short ACA efforts here at St. Michael's. We were determined that we have now also surpassed our goal. As of Thursday the 6th amount received from 282 identified-by-name-and-address contributors (and many unidentified whom comprise approximately 11% of the parish) which as of Thursday the 6th amounted to \$120,359. This included contributions from 282 identified-by-name-and-address contributors (and many unidentified whom comprise approximately 11% of the parish). Our parish is one of the 18 parishes (among the total of 98 parishes in the Diocese of Trenton) that have reached their Annual Catholic Appeal goal for the 2022 calendar year.



(which in the language of fundraising and development is the net aggregate amount of collected funds). And with prudent encouragement-interim tally and the \$109,000 goal as a hedge against uncollected pledges, we continued our efforts over the past few weeks and recently passed our goal in "collected funds" to \$115,465. That \$115,465 sum was from pledgers or check-writing or credit-card contributors (including unquantified cash contributors) all of which as of Thursday the 6th amounted to \$120,359. This included contributions from 282 identified-by-name-and-address contributors (and many unidentified whom comprise approximately 11% of the parish). Our parish is one of the 18 parishes (among the total of 98 parishes in the Diocese of Trenton) that have reached their Annual Catholic Appeal goal for the 2022 calendar year.

So for the fifth consecutive year our parish has reached its Annual Appeal goal and in doing so St. Michael's has again helped the Diocese in a vitally important way to continue to provide the ministries and services that are supported by the ACA and (not to be discounted) has enabled our/your parish to earn the 15% rebate of collected funds payable to parishes that reach their ACA goals. That rebate (in excess of \$16,000) will enable St. Michael's to undertake and complete several projects later this year and in 2023 that might otherwise have been deferred or cancelled.

So, once again, CONGRATULATIONS! And THANK YOU! for your financial and prayerful support of the Diocese of Trenton Annual Catholic Appeal 2022 and for your generous sacrifices for this cause. May God bless you for your generosity and kindnesses. With prayers and gratitude,
