MARRIAGES

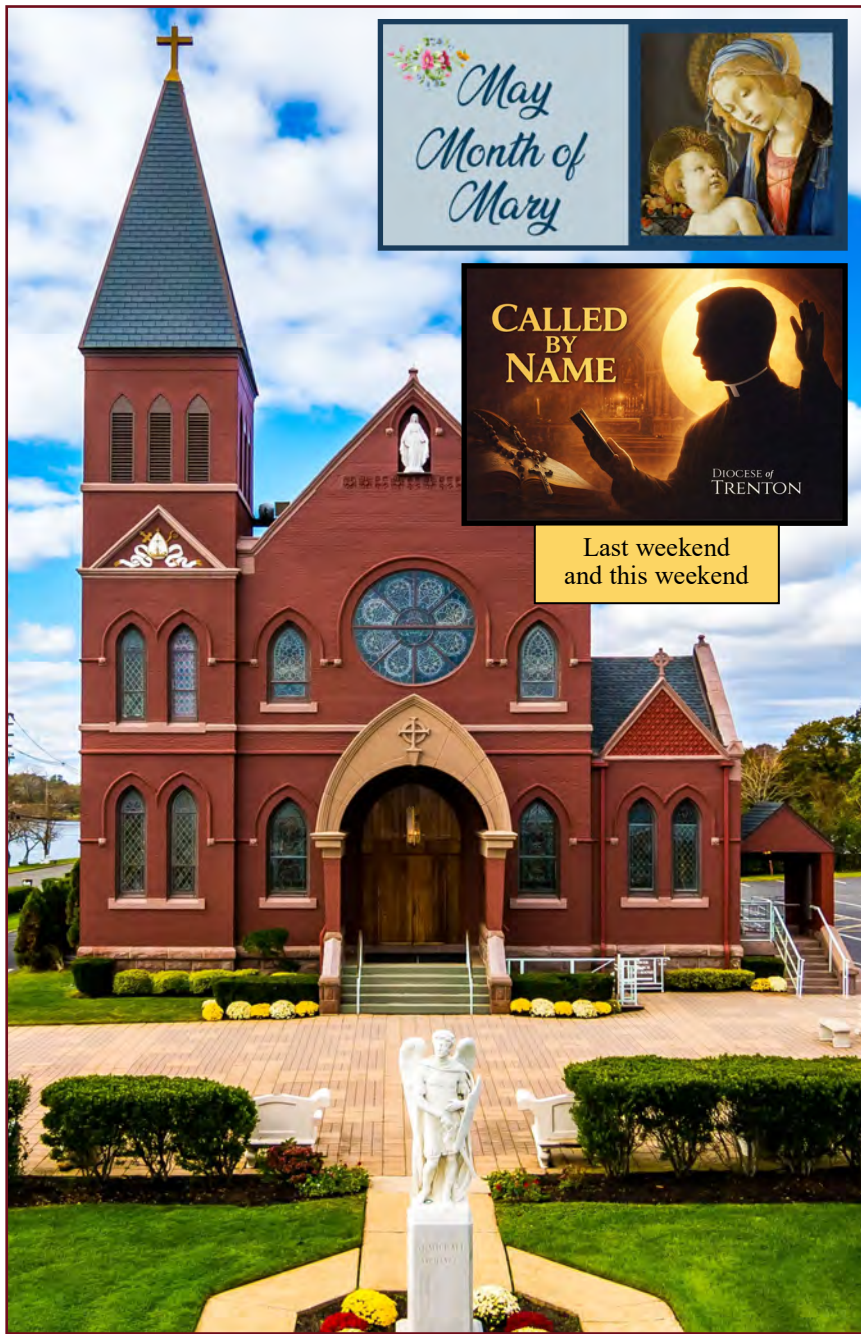

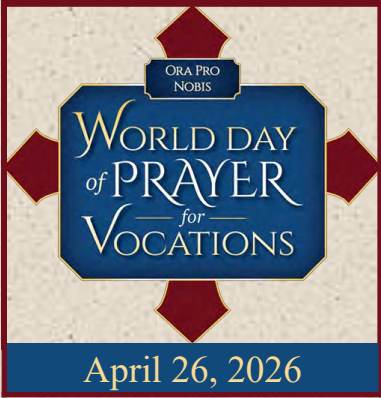

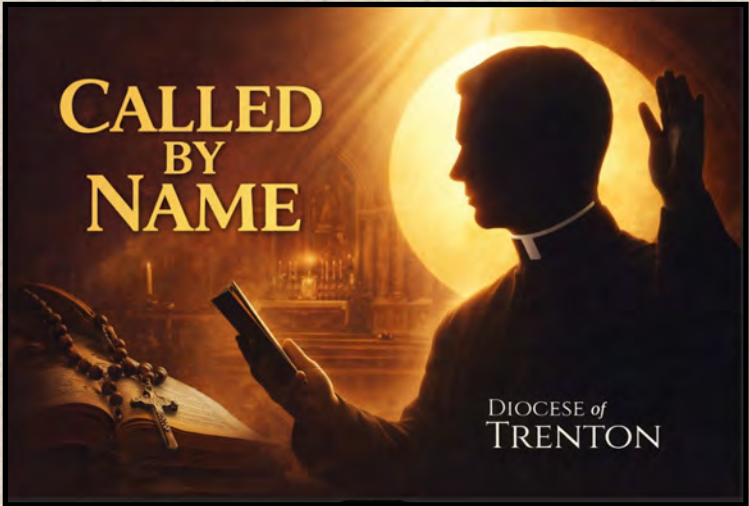

BAPTISM GODPARENTS AND CONFIRMATION SPONSORS

Have you been asked to be a Baptism GODPARENT? Have you been asked to SPONSOR someone who is preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, or for an adult in the OCIA program?



It is an honor and a privilege to be asked. You are seen as someone whom a family, child, teenager, or adult looks up to as living the Christian Catholic faith in a complete, strong, and exemplary manner. You model that behavior and faith in the way that you live your life.

To receive a letter signed and sealed by the Pastor to verify your eligibility to serve as a Baptism Godparent or as a Confirmation Sponsor (such letters are required by (and issued by) virtually all Catholic parishes in the United States including St. Michael's), please keep the following eligibility criteria in mind:

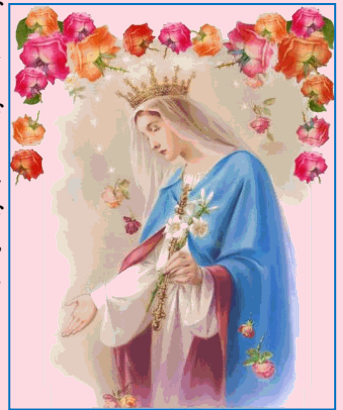
- Registered at (for at least three months) and active parishioner of St. Michael's Church.
- At least 16 years of age.
- Completed all Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation).
- If married, married in the Catholic Church according to Catholic Church Law, or with the express permission of the Church. If unmarried, living a chaste single life (including not cohabitating).
- Attend Mass on all Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation and receive the sacraments of the Church regularly.

The Church takes very seriously the role of being a sponsor. Choosing a sponsor is to be based on the person's dedication to the faith and consistent practice thereof.

Sponsor letters will be gladly and happily given to individuals who meet all of these criteria and who have been **registered members of our parish for at least three months**. If there are any questions or concerns regarding the Church's teaching on these matters or on the criteria for and interpretation of the qualifications for Baptism godparenthood or Confirmation sponsorship, please feel free to call the parish office to arrange for a telephone conversation or meeting with Fr. Butler.

THIS Sunday, May 3 at 10:00 A.M. May Crowning of Mary

May is a month of special Marian devotion to our Blessed Mother. The Catholic tradition of the "May Crowning" celebrates and honors our Mother Mary, Queen of Heaven. ***This year our May Crowning will take place this weekend during the 10:00 a.m. Mass on Sunday, May 3.***



Crowning the statue of the Lord's Mother is symbolic of the honor we give her as the one chosen by God to bear His Son. During the Month of May, a month both named for and dedicated to Mary, Catholics have long honored her by placing a crown on her statue.

Many of our parish's First Holy Communion children, who will have received their First Holy Communion on the previous day (Saturday, May 2), will be participating in this May Crowning of the Blessed Mother and will be dressed again (as is traditional) in their First Holy Communion outfits.

Members of the parish's Rosary Altar Society will also be participating in the May Crowning of Mary. All are invited and welcome.

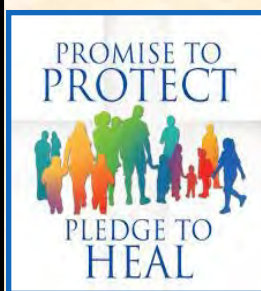
DIOCESE OF TRENTON HOSTS THE MASS THIS YEAR!

Communion Visits; Confession Visits; Anointing of the Sick



Please keep in mind that the parish priests and our lay Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist are available and eager to bring Communion to parishioners who are in the hospital (nursing homes, assisted living facilities, rehab centers, and hospices, too) and to parishioners who are at home but unable to get to church. Please contact Mary Valan at the parish office to make arrangements. Hospitals and other healthcare facilities **generally do not notify the parish office** regarding their Catholic patients who desire to receive Sacraments. And so it falls to the patient herself/himself or to a family member or friend to contact the parish office to make the request. The parish priests will also very gladly make a hospital visit or home visit to hear a Confession and/or administer the Sacrament of the Sick (“Anointing of the Sick”) in addition to bringing Holy Communion. Please remember to contact the parish office to make these arrangements. Thank you.

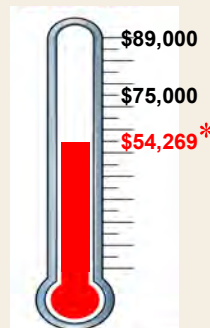
